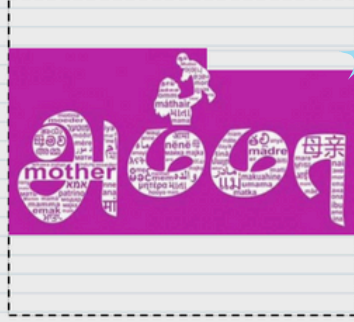


தமிழ்க்கதம்பம்

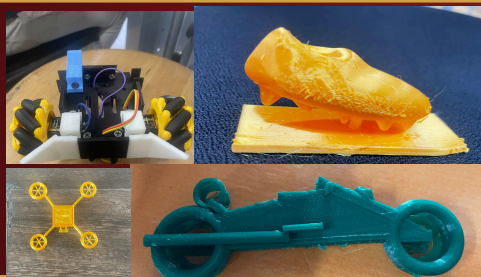
ICT
