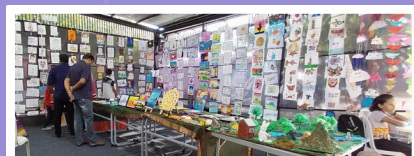

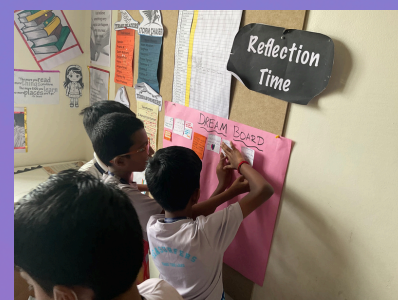
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PRIMARY PANAROMA

This October, our primary students embarked on an exciting journey during Mental Health Week, filled with activities that promote well-being and emotional awareness..

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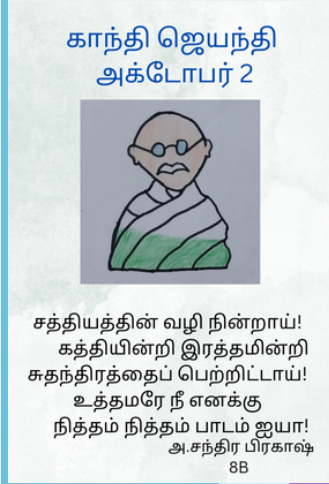
