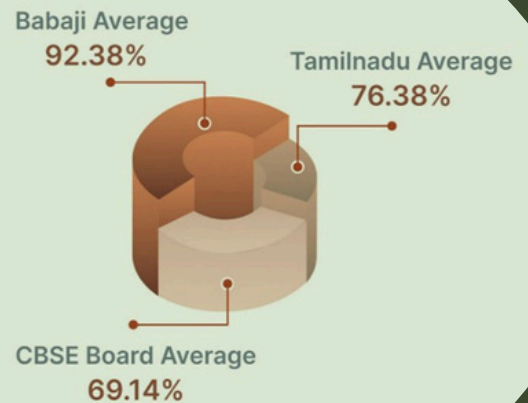
BABAJI VIDHYASHRAM IS NOW TN'S TOP-RATED CBSE SCHOOL

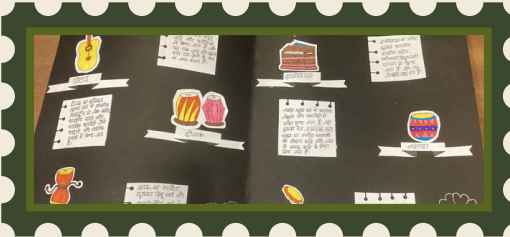
